#### **CRITERIA FOR ASSESSMENT / SELECTION:**

**A. 20% STEADIEST KITE:** This category evaluates the kite's stability in the air, with the highest score on the kite that exhibits the least movement.

**B. 30% CONSTRUCTION, ORIGINALITY, CREATIVITY, AND DESIGN:** Judges will assess kites based on their originality, uniqueness, and visual impact. The focus will be on finding kites that are distinctive and artistically appealing.

**C. 50% KITE SIZE**: The scoring in this category is based on the square footage of the kite's sail area, with larger kites receiving higher scores.













### COMPETITION RULES:

- 1. REGISTRATION IS FREE OF CHARGE.
- 2. Pre-Registration Mandatory: All kite entries must be pre-registered before the event. Kindly submit your entry forms to the Secretariat by 5 PM on or before February 8, 2025. Pre-registration forms and attachments can be emailed to secretariat@panagbengaflowerfestival.com or submitted to the Secretariat Office at 2F BCVB BLDG. Jose Abad Santos Drive, Burnham Park, Baguio City
- 3. **Entry Requirements:** ENTRY forms must include a photo or a colored sketch of the original kite and its size and dimensions. Check-in at the registration desk is required on the day of the event. A mandatory safety briefing will take place before the competition begins.
- 4. **Minor Participants:** Minors participating in the contest must be accompanied by a parent or guardian for registration and during the competition.
- 5. **Material Choice:** Participants may use any materials for their kite, including paper, cloth, light wood, bamboo, etc., with metal connectors allowed. The use of environmentally friendly and recycled materials is encouraged.

- 7. Kites must be self-made. Commercially bought kites are not eligible.
- 8. **Design:** Kites must be safe and manageable. Sharp objects and materials that could cause injury or damage are prohibited.
- 9. **Originality and Restrictions:** Kites must be original creations and not used in previous Panagbenga Kite Flying Competitions. Designs should not closely resemble the Philippine Flag.
- 10. **Size Specifications:** Kites smaller than 9 square feet can use only one runner. Kites larger than 10 square feet may use up to two runners.
- 11. **Material Preference:** Using inexpensive and recycled materials is encouraged. Marshals will assist with the launch
- 12. **Launch and Retry:** Kites get a 5-minute launch period. A second attempt is allowed if the first fails; failure in the second attempt leads to disgualification. Entangled will be disgualified
- 13. **Weather Contingency**: Under low wind or poor weather, the "No Flying Condition Regulations" apply, where kites are assessed without flying.
- 14. **Damage and Repair:** Damaged kites may be repaired in a designated area. Repaired kites can be relaunched to comply with the one-minute flying rule.
- 15. **Assistance Rules:** Friends and family members can assist in launching and repairs, but the kite-maker must fly the kite.
- 16. **Reused and Repurposed Kites**: Kites repurposed or previously entered in Panagbenga competitions will be disqualified.
- 17. **Safety and Conduct**: Participants must follow all safety guidelines as directed by the event organizers.
- 18. Kites with combative designs or capabilities are strictly prohibited.
- 19. Respectful and courteous behavior is expected from all participants.
- 20. **Non-Competing Entries**: Previously used kites in Panagbenga competitions, whether winning or not, are non-competing.
- 21. **Participants compete at their own risk.** The organizers are not responsible for any accidents or injuries.
- 22. Participants are responsible for the clean-up of their area.
- 23. **Final Decision:** The Selection Committee's decisions regarding the competition and its results are final.
